Visitors to the museum are invited to journey through the Quaker influence on the modern world: explore the industrial revolution, developments in science and medicine, astronomy, the abolition of slavery, social reform, and ecology; delight in the detail of the stunning needlework and the craftsmanship involved in its creation; and admire the Georgian Meeting House, which celebrates its 200th anniversary in 2016.

With interactive displays, films, audio guides and children's activities there's something for visitors of all ages.
