Despite regular ongoing maintenance, major repairs and improvements are needed to the Meeting House in Kendal...



The panels were created in the 1980s and 1990s through a community project involving over 4,000 people in 15 countries.

The work will prevent damp and water damage to interior spaces including the Quaker Tapestry Museum, artefact collection storage and community rooms.

It will also contribute to wider energy conservation and environmental sustainability.

Coping with Kendal's rain...

- install breathable underlay
- renew leads to gutters and porches
- repair chimneys
- carry out associated joinery
- repair south porch masonry
- install bat boxes
- address internal condensation/ventilation issues
