We receive no regular grant funding from central Quaker funds or other sources.

Reduced government support, lower visitor numbers and a lack of Room Hire income, mean we need help now to ride out this crisis until full recovery.

We have lost the summer months income from activities which normally substantially meet Quaker Tapestry's running costs.
